Mick Read brought up a minor point in that there was not enough white wine loads of red mostly drunk by Curley, this will be taken into consideration for the dinner.

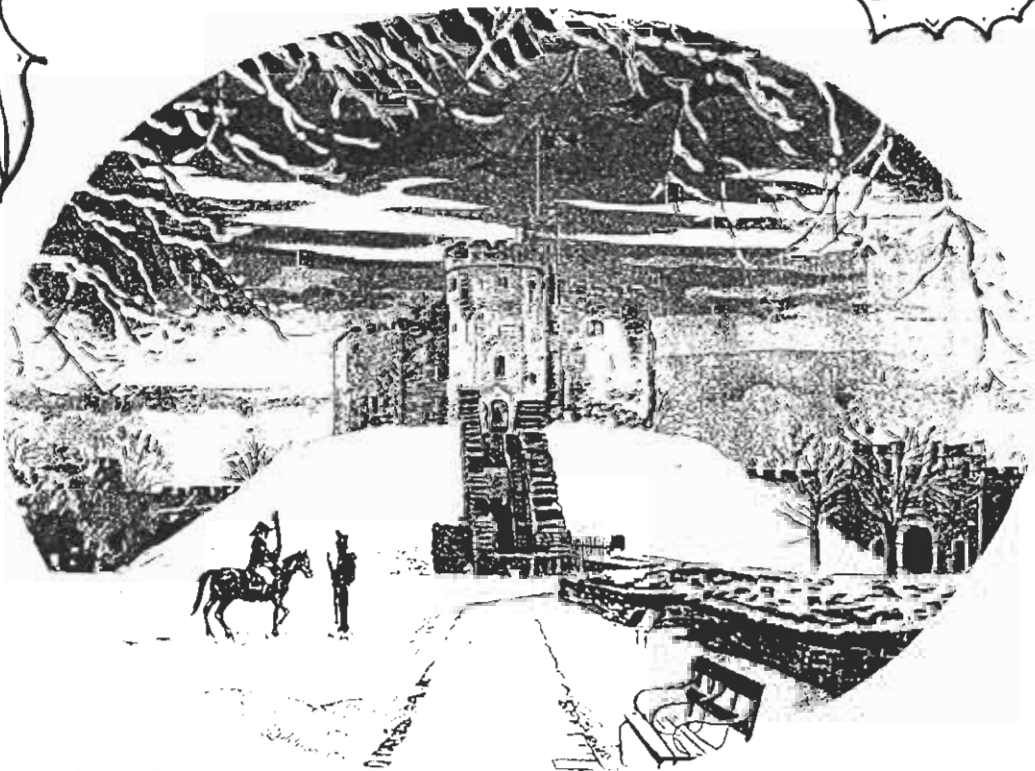
8. Remembrance Day. There were various points which members wish to be discussed at the next meeting regarding the parade on the sea front.
